TAXES ARE DUE

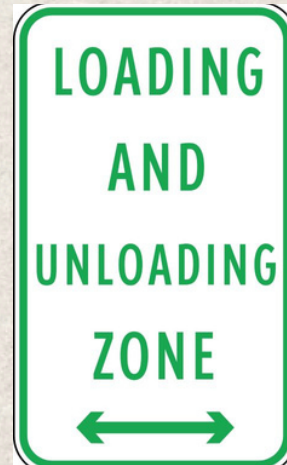
The Village of Clyde taxes were due on **December 31, 2024**.
